* Description	<p>This course is designed for third-year students in the translation program of the English department. It aims at acquainting students with the knowledge of the dissimilarities between Chinese and English and applying it to Chinese-to-English translation practice. Students will develop skills in translation through contrastive study in semantics, word order, grammatical structure, discourse organization, idiomatic expressions in the two languages. Essays involving topics in politics, economics, culture and related issues will be covered in the training and students are expected to be able to translate from Chinese to English newspaper articles of intermediate difficulty level in the afore mentioned fields. The course features interactive teaching and learning experience by encouraging students to participate fully in class discussion and real-life projects. Apart from imparting knowledge of translation the course has a clear focus on integrating translation skills with language</p>
